## **Use Cases: Algo Speaker & Visual Alerters**

An Algo speaker can be paired using a hunt/ring group to ring when an extension is called, providing a louder ring. This is a great solution for loud /noise areas where ambient noise levels may be high.



An Algo visual alert such as the Algo 8128 pr Algo 8138 can be paired using a hunt/ring group to flash when an extension is called. This is a great solution for areas where a ring might not be heard, or to alert people with hearing impairments.



An Algo 8028 can be configured to dial a single extension or hunt group for visitor communication when the call button on the intercom station is pressed. The intercom can also be called directly and the end-port will auto-answer. The 8028 kit also provides a Normally Open (NO or Normally Closed (NC) replay to integrate with a door/gate locking mechanism or access control panel. A momentary open code can be entered via the telephone extension keypad during the intercom call to active the relay for visitor access.
